Support Staff Positions *	
Assistant Supervisor	Provides supervision of instructional staff. Helps Assistant Camp Director with implementing programming, staff evaluations, and safety. Certified for all aspects of camp programs.
Head Group Leader	Oversees evening programs, supervises group leaders. Assists Camp Director with implementing evening programming, staff evaluations, and safety.
Range Safety Officer	Supervises range safety and all shooting sports programs.
Instructor Positions *	
Wetland Wonderers	Provides conservation education program focusing on wetland systems through hikes and hands-on activities to $3^{\rm rd}-5^{\rm th}$ grade campers.
Wildlife Adventurers	Provides conservation education program focusing on Florida wildlife through hikes and hands-on activities to $3^{\rm rd}-5^{\rm th}$ grade campers.
Outdoor Archers	Implements our bowhunting program to 6th – 8 th grade campers.
Anglers	Implements our freshwater fishing program to 3 rd and 4 th grade campers.
Anglers Plus*	Implements our advanced freshwater fishing program to 6 th – 8 th grade campers. Includes off site excursions.
Explorers	Provides conservation education program with hiking and camping adventures for our 5^{th} and 6^{th} grade campers.
Pathfinders	Implements the hunter safety program to $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ grade campers.
Seafarers*	Implements the saltwater fishing program to 6^{th} – 8^{th} grade campers. Includes off site excursions.
Mariners*	Provides marine ecology instruction to 7 th and 8 th graders. Includes off site excursions
Leadership Camp Supervisor	Supervises the leadership camp (high school) program, assigns duties, provides training to campers.
Archery	Provides archery instruction to all campers.
Paddle Sports	Provides basic paddling skills for canoe, kayak, and paddle boards to all campers.
Lifeguard	Supervises swimming at waterfront (pond) for all campers.
Fishing/Sports	Provides fishing and sport opportunities for all campers.
Other Positions	
Group Leader	Facilitates evening programs; Sleep in cabins with campers to provide supervision for up to 16 campers; assist instructors for $\frac{1}{2}$ day.
Kitchen Staff	Prepares meals for children, cleans and maintains kitchen to Health Department Standards, Assists in kitchen with cleaning and washing of dishes, empties trash, food preparations as needed.
